CWF CHALLENGE

The AUXILIARY is challenging the LEGION, SAL and RIDERS to raise the most Money by April 15 money to donate to the <u>American Legion</u> <u>Child Well-Being Foundation</u>. Last year nationwide over \$852,593 was awarded to support youth-serving projects.



The American Legion Children and Youth National Programs in 2025 was awarded \$525.000 to cover our national capstone events American Legion National Oratorical Contest, Boys Nation, Junior Shooting Sports program National Championships, and American Legion Baseball.

In October 2024, the American Legion "Child Welfare Foundation" officially changed its name to the "Child Well-Being Foundation" (CWF), continuing its mission to support children's holistic needs.

<u>Mission</u>: The foundation provides grants to nonprofit organizations that support the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual wellbeing of children across the United States. Founded in 1954 by The American Legion and Commander Dr. Garland D. Murphy, Jr. Commander Murphy donated mineral rights from oil-rich land in Montana and North Dakota to help establish the foundation. Originally focused on child welfare, the foundation expanded its scope to reflect a more holistic view of child development, prompting the recent name change.

<u>Grantmaking</u>: The foundation disseminates information about health, education, safety, and social-emotional development. This includes projects that enhance the lives of military children, provide comfort and care, and promote hope for America's youth. Grants are awarded only to nonprofit entities that serve children in the U.S.

<u>How to Contribute</u>: Donations can be made online through the American Legion Child Well-Being Foundation donation portal <u>CWF Inc - Donate</u>, options include one-time or recurring gifts, and donors can dedicate their contributions in honor of someone. Alternately, donations will be made as a "Post 25 Family Donation", from monies collected by the "family challenge" mentioned above. CWF small white piggy banks are also available to take home and fill with coins (to get one contact the Auxiliary).

Military History Snapshot

April 15, 1969: The North Korean military shoots down a U.S. Navy EC-121 aircraft over the Sea of Japan, killing all 31 on board. The EC-121M Warning Star was on a reconnaissance mission when a North Korean MiG-17 shot it down over the Sea of Japan in international airspace. There was never a U.S. diplomatic or military response. (Ref. 1969 EC-121 Shootdown Incident)

Windows 10 Extended Security Updates Until October 2026

Windows 10 "Feature Updates" (application improvements) ended last month, however Microsoft offers a one year extension on "Security Updates" (protection from bad actors) to give individuals more time to get a Windows 11 computer. Navigate to Windows Update, select Extend Security Updates (ESU) near the bottom of the screen. Select Enroll Now and follow the screen prompts. If your computer has been backing up to your Microsoft Account, then the message will state No Cost. If you have never backed up to your Microsoft Account, then the cost will be \$30. Most people back up to their Microsoft Accounts, so \$30 would be rare. The final message will be Your PC is enrolled to receive Extend Security Updates (ESU). Total time to do this is less than a minute. To increase your protection, ensure you also have a paid or free virus protection app installed.

Windows 11

The latest Windows 11 Version 25H2 Update is currently being rolled out. It builds on the innovations introduced in the 2024 release, delivering a more polished, secure, and intelligent Windows experience. While this update doesn't introduce major new features, it activates enhancements that have been gradually rolled out over the past year ensuring your device is up to date with the latest refinements.
